

Ironmen and Severn Gilders Morris – Information for members

Code of Conduct:

When performing as a member of the IMSG or wearing the kit you are representing the good name of the Morris Side and expected not to do anything that might bring that name into disrepute. Please ensure you follow any instruction from any Squire or Bandmaster and do not absent yourself without first advising your Squire or Bandmaster.

Within the club at all other times please conduct yourself with consideration of the other members and how you would yourself expect others to behave, be punctual, polite, let others have their say and treat all members and the public with respect.

The Roles of the Officers:

The Officers work together as a committee to run the club on behalf of the members. Officers are elected annually at the AGM in Oct. Officers' posts can be jointly held. Any member can be co-opted to the committee.

Some Officers have more defined roles, but in their absence another Officer can step in. A brief outline of the defined Officers' roles is as follows:

Band Leader: Organises the band

Foremen (Gilders' and Ironmen's): Runs the practice night & teaches the dances

Publicity: Publicises the teams and organises recruitment events.

Secretary: Organises the diary of dance-outs and events and the formal business of the club (General and Officers Meetings).

Squires (Gilders' and Ironmen's): Runs the dance-outs with the other squire and band leader.

Treasurer: Collects subscriptions and deals with the finances of the club

Members can approach any Officer on any matter.

GDPR processes

Members complete a form to provide information for the club to contact them. Relevant data from the form is put into an email circulation list (email address), an electronic register (all information) and the dance-out schedule (name known by). When your membership ceases all of the data is deleted and the form destroyed. Information is only used for the purpose of organising dance-outs and events and attending other's dance-out and events. The electronic register is only available to the officers. Individual email addresses are not made public. Members can elect to have their full name, mail address and mobile telephone number made available to all members through a list on the member's area of the website.
